• Discussion:

- Mr. John Jaramillo inquired about the existence of multiple AI TOP Codes and whether there are discussions regarding a new AI TOP Code. Dr. Crete responded that there are ongoing conversations at the statewide level. The COE has collaborated with colleges to ensure they select the appropriate TOP Code, noting that AI skills are similar to those related to drones, which may fall under various TOP Codes. It is likely that AI will not be categorized under a single TOP Code, as it represents a skill rather than a specific occupation, with numerous occupations being influenced by AI technology.
- Mr. Jaramillo suggested that Fullerton College verify the TOP Code for the "Plant-Based Nutrition and Sustainable Horticulture Certificate." He recommended that Fullerton consider the alignment with the 01 Agriculture and Natural Resources TOP Code.

VI. Update, Discussion, and/or Action Item

Ms. Dorsie Brooks, CRLC and Dean Resource Associate, OCRC

- a. Program Recommendation Flow Chart/Process

VII. Updates

- a. Coastline: Mr. Harrison announced that Coastline is implementing competency-based education, with plans to launch in the spring. They will host a virtual event on February 7th alongside Mount SAC and Southwestern College to discuss direct assessment and its rollout. Additionally, Ms. Gallyon is collaborating with Mr. Santos to plan a series of CPL convenings for the spring.

- *c.* Fullerton: Fullerton convened at the district to discuss their approach to collecting the Vision 2030 measures. They are currently in progress with this initiative.

- *h.* Saddleback: Mr. Jaramillo shared that Saddleback College has received a grant from the National Security Administration in collaboration with the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, aimed at upskilling Guam's cybersecurity workforce, which faces significant challenges. Saddleback will concentrate on research and training; they will support Guam in defending its infrastructure and communication systems. The initiative will also involve partnerships with various military agencies and the NSA.
- *i.* Santa Ana: Dr. Sergeyeva announced that SAC has received two additional planning apprenticeship grants and is currently in the process of hiring a new director. The new director will oversee the planning for these grants, bringing the total to five.
- *j.* Santiago Canyon: Ms. Foley shared that Ms. Elena Gates, a faculty member in the Real Estate department, hosted a successful event that brought together industry professionals and students. The event was also shared on social media. Ms. Elizabeth Arteaga announced that she has hired her second Director for the Apprenticeship Program. She is enthusiastic about having a complete team that will focus on both traditional and non-traditional apprenticeship areas.
