Danielle Alarid and Diego Mosquera presented four proposed baccalaureate programs for regional review, following new Cycle 6-7 LMI endorsement criteria. Diego outlined the criteria, supply gap, job outlook, living wage comparison, degree alignment, work experience, and salary differentials; he confirmed all four programs received LMI endorsement.

Discussion focused on:

- Code Alignment: Concerns over SOC/SIP/TOP code matching, duplication risks, and CSU/UC sensitivities (especially with "cyber" terminology).
- Scope of Review: Clarifying that the regional body reviews for local (Orange County) non-duplication, not statewide duplication.
- Process Gaps: Acknowledgment that this is an interim "stopgap" process due to the August 15 submission deadline; a more formal review process will be developed

later.

- Program Similarities: Noted overlap between two Coastline programs with identical occupational codes but different focus areas.
- **Voting Concerns:** Several members preferred confirming programs had been *reviewed* rather than formally *approved* due to limited curriculum detail and time constraints.

Outcome:

Motion passed to record that the four proposed baccalaureate degree applications have been *reviewed* by the Orange County Regional Consortium, allowing colleges to proceed with state submission under current timelines.
