Update, Discussion, and/or Action Item

Ms. Dorsie Brooks, CRLC and Dean Resource Associate, OCR

a. Regional Collaboration and Coordination Grant update

Mr. Michael Sacoto, OCRC Interim Executive Director

Michael provided an update noting that today's collaborative meeting will primarily serve as a listening session for college partners, though external partners are still welcome to participate. He shared a survey in the chat outlining the RFA focus areas, which is open to deans, TDRDs, and K12 partners to submit written feedback, especially for those who were unable to attend prior listening sessions.

He also shared that the first draft of the RFA is expected to be released to the deans the following Monday, as grant writing begins today and the team will not have a complete draft ready by November 24. He thanked all contributors for their insights, noting that the input gathered so far has informed the initial framework of the application.

Michael added that today's meeting will include updates from the Chancellor's Office, TDRDs, and the Center of Excellence before transitioning into the listening session. He confirmed the survey may be shared broadly with faculty, counselors, administrators, employers, and any stakeholders who can contribute to shaping the consortium's objectives for 2026 to 2029.

VII. College Updates

REGIONAL CONSORTIUM

- a. **Fullerton:** Ken shared that the college is hiring two full-time faculty positions: a Cinema/Television instructor and a Drone Technology instructor, noting that the latter will serve as an interesting pilot effort.
- b. **Saddleback:** John reported that a full-time Automotive faculty position will be opening soon and is expected to generate interest. He also noted that the college will begin its presidential search within the next month.
- c. **Santa Ana:** Matthew shared that his team is beginning work on Perkins and the CLNA and is experiencing challenges with inaccurate VTEA data for SCC and SAC. After working with IT without resolution, he may reach out to colleagues to identify contacts at their colleges to compare data and ensure accuracy. John suggested connecting with Kari Irwin at Saddleback, noting her leadership in previous regional efforts to address similar data issues. Dorsie added that Golden West is facing the same challenges and recommended forming a regional workgroup to continue this conversation, especially given the complexity of new special populations reporting requirements.
