The Music Technology certificate prepares students for an entry-level career in music composition and production, music and sound for multimedia, and a variety of music technology career pathways including composer, music engineer, and music technician. Students completing the program will be able to:

- 1. Recognize, write, identify aurally, and perform basic music notation
- 2. Perform assigned level technical exercises and repertoire on the piano
- 3. Describe the skills necessary for success in the music industry
- 4. Demonstrate advanced music recording and production techniques
- 5. Use technology to score and produce music for multimedia

There are no prerequisite skills or enrollment limitations.

The Music Technology certificate prepares students for an entry-level career in music composition and production, music and sound for multimedia, and a variety of music technology career pathways. The certificate can lead to careers in the music industry and/or transfer to a four-year institution. The Music Department has successfully offered this certificate locally for decades, and continues to award numerous Music Technology certificates of achievement each year.
