- i. Mt. SAC's CEO had concerns with two programs that were submitted for recommendation.
  - Legal Support Professional. Top Code submitted 1402 is mis-aligned to Paralegal. Further research was done on the Legal Support Professional which, in their opinion, should be under the top code for Business, it should not be under Paralegal.
  - Dr. Adriene Davis apologized for last minute communication that was received from CEO.
  - Jennifer Galbraith stated that the Top Code's that were submitted on the application were for Paralegal or Legal Secretary. Legal Support Professional does not fit either Top Code's. Mt. SAC's CEO noticed this discrepancy and asked to bring this forward. Jennifer tried to contact Kendra to make her aware of the situation as a courtesy.
  - Juan Madrigal confirmed that there is no Top Code for Legal Support, there's either Legal Office 0510 or 1402 Legal.
  - Kendra Madrid clarified that Top Code's, Program titles and Content are under faculty purview. Kendra will ensure to take any steps necessary for this program to get recommended.
  - Certificate of Achievement in Show Business Commercials, Voice-Over, Film Acting. The LMI report that was originally submitted to the Regional CTE website application was from Inland Empire region. LMI report must be developed by the LA/OC CEO. Gene Carbonaro will upload correct LMI Report to Regional CTE Website.
- ii. Dr. Adriene Davis will be sending Top Code list from Strong Workforce. It has all assigned industries and unassigned for future use.
- iii. Dr. Marcia Wilson reminded everyone of the role as a Dean and also to communicate to the CEO's the three day courtesy notice of notification, in order to submit corrections in a timely matter.
